

SACRED HEART PASTORAL COUNCIL MINUTES

MONDAY, JULY 9, 2012

6:30 p.m.

Present: Fr. Warren Stecklein , Sr. Rebecca, David O’Gwinn, Elaine Coulson, Matt Stucker, Mary Klinge, Barbara Hammond and Tom Giessel (Guest)

Opening: Fr. Warren opened the special-call meeting with prayer.

Minutes: June 21st minutes were approved.

Business of Meeting was the Centennial Projects and Celebration.

Centennial Books: Tom reported that 298 books have been ordered and prepaid. Approximately 1/3 of the book content is family history. Cost of the books is \$70.31 per book for #300 ordered and \$63.00 each for #350 ordered. Tom plans to order the 350 as being most cost-effective. Mary and Pam are proofreading sections as completed now and it is expected the book will go to the printer the last week of July. Matt reported that aerial pictures will be taken of the church grounds.

Christmas Ornaments: Matt presented samples of laser gold-colored ornaments for consideration. He suggested that we continue with the design of the old and new church. There is a \$395 one-time tooling fee for the ornament. Costs are then \$7.00 ea. If #100 to 199 ornaments ordered; \$6.50 each if #200 to 299 ornaments ordered. Ornaments can be purchased with black box with clear lid for \$0.60 ea. Or ziplock bag(sleeve) with cardboard backing for \$0.30 – which can be sent free if we do own packaging. Boxes for the ornaments can also be ordered separately from on-line vendors for \$35.00 for #100 boxes. Delivery of the ornaments would be 8-10 weeks after order is submitted.

M SC/Elaine & David to proceed with the Christmas ornament project.

MSC/Elaine & David to purchase a “limited edition” of #200 ornaments at the cost of \$6.50 ea. With the sleeve and do our own packaging. Matt will check with the company to see if history comes with the ornament and if so we would have that and if not would prepare our own for the package. Tom will check with Tim at the Diocesan office regarding timing of the sale of ornaments in conjunction with the Centennial books.

Invitations: Matt reported that OPI in Larned will make #100 postcard-type invitations at a cost of \$20-30.00.

Raffle Tickets: Matt reported that #500 raffle tickets could be printed at the approximate cost of \$70.00. He would plan to set the pew bench, pen & ink drawing and Centennial Book at the back of church prior to the sale of raffle tickets. Matt will visit with Alvin Huftles to clarify what needed for the

pen & ink drawing. It was suggested that a couple cookbooks and Christmas ornaments be added to the raffle.

Centennial Prayer Magnets: #500 magnets will be ordered to be used as give-a-way mementos of the centennial celebration.

Centennial Cookbooks: Mary reported the over 400 recipes have been received to date and thus, she expects we will have a cookbook with about 500 recipes. The volunteer typists are busy typing in their assigned sections of the cookbook. The committee will be meeting soon and it is expected the cookbook will sell for around \$10-12.00.

Liturgy - - Matt reported that the Liturgy Committee has agreed to plan the liturgy for the Mass on October 28th.

Outreach Committee - - Matt stated that they have been contacted regarding providing decorations for the Centennial meal. They are in process of reorganizing and when accomplished they will get back to the Pastoral Council with plans.

Catered Meal: Bids were received from Wheatland Café for \$9.00 each for roast beef/chicken dinner and Hammond Gourmet for whole hog presentation at \$6.20. A third bid from Faye Grandy is expected. Preferences were discussed and decision will be made at next meeting.

Matt closed the meeting by leading the group in the Our Father.

Next regular meeting will be Thursday, July 18, 2012, @ 6:30 pm at the Parish Office.
