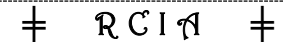

WHAT ARE ALL THE ORANGE FLAGS ABOUT around the church? This question has been heard a number of times the last couple of weeks. As we prepare for our Feasibility Study to help us discern what to do with the present school building, and as we study the options for possibly building on the property, a survey had to be done over the entire property to establish what lines and wires and other things have been run through the property over the last 100 years. This will help us determine from the very beginning what some of our options are, and other things that should not be considered.

FOOD FOR THOUGHT We have been noticing in churches around the area, that when some people come up for Communion, especially some of the children, they appear to be chewing. It is generally regarded as being extremely disrespectful and irreverent to the Most Blessed Sacrament. The Eucharistic Fast for one hour before receiving the Eucharist consists of refraining from any kind of food or drink, from anything that gives pleasure to the sense of taste, so that we are more focused on Communion and more able, as the Scripture urges us, to “taste and see the goodness of the Lord.” It is also difficult to imagine how anyone could receive and reverently consume the Body and Blood of our Blessed Lord when they have gum in their mouth at the same time. We therefore urge all of our parents to be mindful of the importance of showing reverence and respect for the Blessed Sacrament and to remind your children of this before Mass.



The sessions of the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults will begin in September. If you know of anyone who might be interested in inquiring into the Catholic faith, please extend an invitation. The first several weeks will be spent in answering the questions of inquirers and does not mean there is an obligation to join the church. Persons come to inquire only. These sessions may also be informational for Catholics who want an update about their faith. One who gives a personal invitation is responding to the Lord's call to help spread the Gospel.
