THIS PAST WEEK, a group of parishioners requested a meeting regarding some concerns they had with our building project as currently proposed. We would like to thank this group for coming forward and would like to share with the parish the concerns and the steps we are currently taking. **With the re-allocation of space in the design of the new facility, as compared to the old school building, there was a concern whether the new building would allow for extracurricular activities for children during PSR.** After consulting with the architect, it will be possible to go from the original planed ceiling height of 9ft to 10ft 6in at modest cost and without greatly hampering ambiance or acoustics. Also, all the lighting will be flush with the ceiling which will help give additional room. **Would there be larger meeting spaces available for the upper classmen?** We are still investigating into how all the spaces will be used once this building is constructed. One classroom could be enlarged at the expense of a few other rooms to give slightly more room for older youth for simple recreation such as ping pong. Also, the current office building will be converted to classroom and meeting spaces, some of those rooms could be larger.
