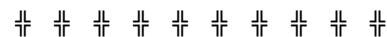

AT THE SUNDAY MASS this weekend, we will celebrate the Rite of Acceptance for catechumens and the Rite of Welcoming for candidates.

WITH OUR THANKSGIVING MASS being on Wednesday evening at 6:00 pm, please note there will not be Mass on Thursday, Thanksgiving Day and there will be a Communion Service on Friday, November 27th at Diversicare of Larned.

CHRISTMAS EVE MASS Once again this year parishioners at both Sacred Heart and Saint Bernard have asked to have the earlier of the two Christmas Eve Masses. In order to accommodate both parishes we polled people via the bulletin to see if they would prefer a 4:00 or 5:00 pm Christmas Eve Mass at Sacred Heart. 82 % of the households that responded said they wanted the 4:00 pm Mass. 18 % of those responding said they wanted the 5:00 pm Mass. Therefore we will plan on having both the Christmas Eve Mass and New Year's Eve Mass at 4:00. Saint Bernard's Masses will be at 6:00 pm and Sacred Heart parishioners are most welcome to join them for their Mass celebrations if their time fits your schedules.



ADVENT ANGELS



During the season of Advent we invite parishioners to participate in the Advent Angels Name Exchange. If your family would like to participate, you are asked to place your family members' names & address into a basket at Masses this weekend, November 21/22 and next weekend, November 28/29 choose an Angel with a family's name on it from the Christmas tree in church. During Advent, we ask you to pray in a special way for the family whom you have drawn. Closer to Christmas, you may decide to send a card, stop in for a visit, give a small gift if you wish, and identify yourself. This is a way of sharing your spirit of faith and love. It may also provide a way to become better acquainted with a new family.
