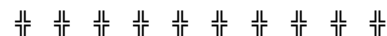

REINTRODUCTION OF BELLS AT CONSECRATION
 As some of you may recall, for centuries bells were rung during the Consecration at Mass. The language of the Mass was Latin, and the bell ringing helped to call people's attention to the altar during the Eucharistic Prayer. In the 1960's when the language changed from Latin to English, many churches discontinued the bell ringing because it was deemed unnecessary since everyone understood the English prayer. However, the church guidelines give us a lot of flexibility as to whether we ring bells or not. An interest has been expressed by numerous people here at Sacred Heart to begin ringing the bells once again. Therefore with our Easter Liturgy, we should once again hear the bells peal in Sacred Heart Church.
