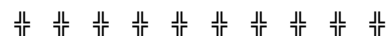

KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS SILVER ROSE

The Silver Rose, a program of the Knights of Columbus honoring Our Lady of Guadalupe, is coming to Sacred Heart Parish on **Tuesday, October 15 at 6:00 pm** at Sacred Heart Church.

Every year, silver roses are stewarded by Knights of Columbus councils along routes from Canada to Mexico. Each stop along the pilgrimage is a rosary-centered occasion for Knights, parishioners and members of the community to pray for the respect of life, the spiritual renewal of each person, and for the advancement of the message of Our Lady of Guadalupe. The first rose, in 1960, was a live one, blessed by a bishop in Ontario, Canada. It traveled to New York and Texas, where it was taken into Mexico. Its journey ended on Dec. 12 at the Basilica of Our Lady of Guadalupe in Monterrey. The Silver Rose program was expanded in 2001. At that time, Carl Anderson, the supreme knight of the Knights of Columbus, said it reaffirmed the organization's dedication to the sanctity of human life.
