Cancellation of Public Masses in the Catholic Diocese of Dodge City due to coronavirus crisis

In conjunction with the bishops of Kansas, effective 1 p.m. March 17, 2020, and until further notice, all public celebrations of the Holy Mass in the Catholic Diocese of Dodge City are cancelled except for funeral Masses. The maximum number of persons gathered in a diocesan function is 10 persons including the Priest.

Adoration chapels are closed at this time.

All Communal Penance Services are cancelled.

Confirmations, First Reconciliations,
First Communions, and Quinceañeras are postponed.

All parish PSR classes, adult faith formation classes, events and meetings are cancelled or postponed.

Holy Week and RCIA:
All Holy Week liturgies are cancelled.

Those who are ill and vulnerable should stay at home.

We encourage parishioners to continue sharing your tithe and alms to the parish by electronic giving, checks mailed to the church, or left in the drop box by the front door of the parish center.

Fr. Bernard will continue to offer Masses by himself. The Northeast door of the Church will be open from 9:00 am to 7:00 pm each day for anyone wishing to make a prayerful visit to the Blessed Sacrament.

All the faithful are encouraged to join together in prayer to our Loving God for the health and protection of our diocese, nation and world for an end to this crisis.
