TO MASK OR NOT TO MASK. . . The wearing of a face mask or face covering (bandana, scarf, etc.) is strongly encouraged during this coronavirus pandemic. This is an act of charity, compassion, justice, and humility. The virus can be transmitted (at times, the person may not know he/she has the disease), and virus can be received. Masks reduce the chance of transmitting or receiving coronavirus. A priest, deacon or EMC is required to wear a mask when he/she is distributing communion.

The CDC points out that some should *not* wear a mask: “children under age 2, anyone who has trouble breathing, or is unconscious, incapacitated or otherwise unable to remove the mask without assistance.”

We should not judge a person because he/she is not wearing a mask in public. For example, some may have decreased lung capacity (like Pope Francis), others may suffer from claustrophobia (like my dad did). We ask the intercession of St. Bernardine of Sienna, patron saint of lungs and respiratory problems, who cared for the ill during the plague around the year 1400.
