- ❖ Minutes of the August 23rd meeting were approved as presented.
- ❖ The group reviewed the financial reports for August 2011 reflecting \$30,210.45 in income and \$20,835.28 in expenses for a net income of \$9,375.16.
- ❖ Sr. Rebecca Otter, a Dominican sister from Great Bend, approached the council to see if there is a need that she could fill in our parish, working part-time. She does not want to assume the responsibilities already being handled by someone else and suggested helping with the liturgy and assisting Fr. Warren. She could visit the shut-ins and sick and provide sacramental instructions. The sisters excused themselves from the remainder of the meeting.
- ❖ Matt Stucker presented information and a demonstration of the website being considered for the parish. A representative of Solutio, Inc, met with the Pastoral Council and they strongly recommend pursuing the project. The maximum cost would be \$2900/year which would be offset by selling advertising. After discussion, the motion was made and approved to proceed with the website.
- ❖ Under new business: The group discussed payment and services of the Dominican Sisters. After discussion the motion was made and carried to welcome Sr. Rebecca if she chooses to accept the part-time position.

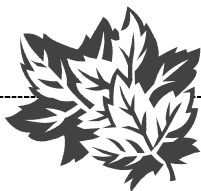

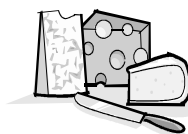
There are **lots** of things going on this month and so parents watch for the monthly

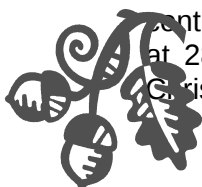
