Assisting with RCIA



Although Sacred Heart Church has a small group of individuals who specifically assist with the RCIA process, it is considered to be the work of the whole parish. So the question may be asked: What can I, as an ordinary lay member of the parish, do to assist the RCIA team in their ministry? Here are several suggestions.

- Pray regularly for the RCIA team members and our catechumens or candidates.
- If you are not already familiar with the catechumens or candidates, find out who they are (their pictures will usually be in the church vestibule), introduce yourself to them and their family members, and welcome them into our parish. These individuals will hopefully become active members of our parish (which is emphasized during RCIA sessions) and will be a part of our Sacred Heart family.
- Attend the special occasions (Rites) associated with the RCIA, such as the Rite of Acceptance (usually in the fall), the Scrutinies during Lent, and the Easter Vigil liturgy in which new catechumens and candidates receive the sacraments of initiation. This will allow you to welcome them as members of the parish.
- Invite non-Catholic friends or associates to attend Mass with you. Talk to them about the Mass and show them around the church. Answer any questions they may have (if you do not know the answer to any of their questions, admit it, and then find out the answer – you may ask RCIA team members for assistance). Inviting someone to attend Mass may arouse curiosity and interest in that individual which may result in his or her desire to become Catholic and lead them into the RCIA process. Also invite former Catholics to come back to Mass. If a person had been away from the Church for some time, he or she may wish to attend RCIA sessions to re-acquaint themselves with Catholic culture, customs, and teachings.

- ❖ Met October 16th

- ❖ Minutes of the September 18th meeting were approved.
- ❖ The group reviewed the financial reports for September reflecting \$29,001.62 in income and \$23,395.44 in expenses for a net income of \$5,606.18. Our YTD net income is \$3,167.21. Total assets at the end of Sept. were \$558,655.22 compared to \$534,678.61 at this time last year.
- ❖ Old Business:
 - a. Parish sprinkler system: David Spare will commit to his estimate until spring and will probably be buying pipe throughout the winter.
 - b. It was decided to grind the evergreen stumps on the north side of the church instead of having them completely removed.
 - c. The group entertained the Diocesan Seminary Endowment Challenge at the parish level. A motion was made and carried that Sacred Heart donate \$1,500 which will qualify for a matching donation.
 - d. Fr. Warren reported that approximately 15-20 people participated in the church clean-up day and that all the tasks had been completed.
- ❖ New Business:
 - a. Pam reported that we received \$671.79 from Kroger from uploads to the Dillons cards tied to Sacred Heart. The cards can be used at the pumps at Kwik Shop as well as Dillons now.
 - b. Don is installing rubber bumpers on the kneelers in church.
