Participation in the Mass – Part 3

This is my third article which strives to mostly encourage and inform my fellow parishioners and visitors to our Church on how to actively participate in the Mass. We have heard it many times before. Liturgy of the Word and Liturgy of the Eucharist, to express what the Mass is. Liturgy of the Word we understand to be God's Word found in the Bible readings. Liturgy of the Eucharist we understand to be Christ's divine sacrifice for us in the work of our redemption.

What is Liturgy? In Christian tradition, it means the participation of the people of God in the "work of God." Through the liturgy Christ, our redeemer and high priest, continues the work of our redemption in, with, and through His Church. CCC 1069. The Liturgy is also a participation in Christ's own prayer to the Father in the Holy Spirit. In the Liturgy, all Christian prayer finds its source and goal. Through the liturgy the inner man is rooted and grounded in "the great love with which [The Father] loved us" in his beloved Son. CCC 1073. Christ glorified... from the time of the Church of the Apostles... is present in the earthly liturgy...which participates in the liturgy of heaven. CCC pg. 282-283. Many church scholars refer to the Mass as "Heaven on Earth."

So, it is **important. We need to participate.** Not just be present. Immerse ourselves in the mystery of God and celebrate. My earlier articles encouraged you to open up the missal and follow through the mass prayers by responding in words and actions. Now, I want to encourage specifically your participation in the singing at Mass, not necessarily by joining the choir, that is an option; but, by singing quietly or vocally aloud with the choir, while sitting in the pews. The board on the Left side of the Sacristy with numbers displayed are the sung responses (both music and words) during Mass. For example, the Gloria, the Alleluia, the Holy, Holy, the Communion response, the Great Amen and the Lamb of God. They are found in the back pages of the Music Issue. The board on the Right side of the Sacristy displays the music for our Entrance, Offertory, Communion and Dismissal hymns. They are also found in the Music Issue.

We have all heard the adage. **He who sings prays twice**, "be filled with the Spirit, addressing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody to the Lord with all your heart." Ephesians 5: 18-19. **Take the time to look at the words you need to be singing** or lip syncing. **They are prayers.** These are some of my favorites.
