Have you decided who you are going to vote for president of the United States on November 5th?

As you ponder that question please consider what I wrote in the May 2024 edition of the Sacred Heart Beat in my article “My Personal Path to Heaven” under the subtitle Keeping the Ten Commandments item number 5: “Thou shall not kill”. On the record I am opposed to murder, whether it be the direct killing of another human being, or the indirect killing of another human being by voting for a politician who supports abortion.

Let’s look at one example of a voting booth sin. A voter believes in “abortion rights” and for that reason knowingly and deliberately votes for a candidate who has promised to protect those “rights.” That is a sin. The voter has intentionally helped someone who is attempting to advance a violent and destructive activity. The vote in that case is similar to the sinful act of taking part in a pro-abortion rally, writing an editorial letter that expresses support for abortion, or otherwise encouraging or enabling those who perform abortions.

To say this has nothing to do with being partisan, because anybody of any party at any time might take any position on abortion, and yet this teaching remains the same. Nor is it “telling people how to vote,” but rather pointing out the moral implications of voting.

Please do your own research on this topic. Merely relying on CNN, Fox News, MSNBC, NBC, CBS, and ABC for your research can be dangerous to your own soul. By always voting for the candidate from the same political party because you have always done it this way, may not be the best way to vote. Please vote for the candidate that truly represents your views on the issues, such as abortion.

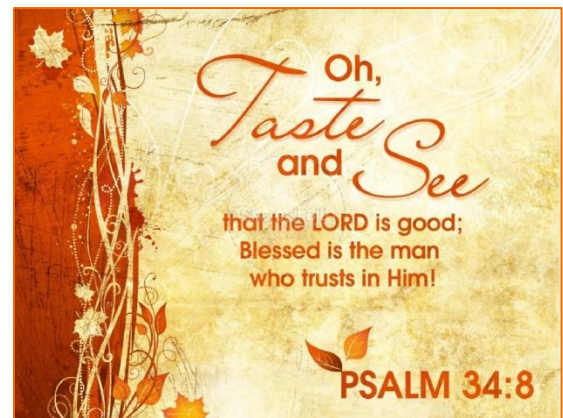
