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SO GLAD YOU ASKED

“Transition of a Pope”

1. Do Popes resign? Pope Celestine V did in 1294. Recently Benedict XVI spent many hours at Celestine's tomb. What do you suppose they talked about? “Shall I resign?” Gregory XII resigned in 1417 to bring about the end of the great Western Schism.

2. Why did Pope Benedict XVI resign? “I have come to the certainty that my strengths due to an advanced age are no longer suited to an adequate exercise of the Petrine ministry”.

3. What is his statue now? No longer responsible for that office, no longer vicar of Peter, no longer head of the college of bishops, not patriarch of the West, not chief bishop of the bishops of Rome, not head of the Vatican City State, no longer infallible. Called Pope Emeritus, with the honor but not the power of a previous position.

4. Who loses their job if the Pope dies or resigns? Cardinals and archbishops in the Roman Curia. Very important matters that cannot wait are entrusted to the College of Cardinals, but final approval in many matters await a new Pope.

5. Who are the three who keep their jobs? Vicar of the diocese of Rome, major penitentiary who deals with confessional matters, and the camerlengo (Cardinal Tarcisio Berrone) who was able to act for the Pope when the Pope was away from Rome.

6. Are there limitations to what the Cardinals can do while the Chair of Peter is empty? They cannot change the rules for electing the next Pope, appoint more Cardinals, or make any binding decisions for the new Pope.

7. How do Cardinals prepare for the Conclave in the Sistine Chapel? PRAY, PRAY, PRAY TO THE HOLY SPIRIT! No campaigning or campaign buttons or billboards. They try to get acquainted with one another.

8. What is a Conclave? The word comes from the Latin word for “with a key”, thus “locked with a key”. The 115 Cardinals younger than 80 are locked away while the voting takes place. They have no radios, TV's, internet, letters, newspapers, telephones, the secretary of the College of Cardinals, master of ceremonies for liturgies, a few religious priests to hear confessions...all these are sworn to the deepest secrecy.

9. Were Popes always chosen by Cardinals? No, in the early church, the Popes were chosen by the clergy and the people of Rome. The present way began in the 11th century.

10. For which person chosen to lead the Church will the Cardinals light a fire that produces white smoke?

Pope Francis!

FINANCE/PROPERTY COUNCIL

- ❖ Met March 19th
- ❖ Members present: Bob Haymaker, Dennis Wilson, G.L. VonFeldt, Carol Jacob, Don Jensen, Leon Sanders, Fr. Warren & Pam Hutfles. John Hutfles also joined the group. Unable to attend: Jim Damm & Sharon Larsen.
- ❖ Minutes of the February 19, 2013 meeting were approved.
- ❖ The group reviewed the financial reports for February reflecting \$20,667.89 in income and \$25,297.30 in expenses for a net income of negative \$4,629.41. Our YTD net loss is \$9,645.47. The loss is attributable to the Centennial Celebration expense. Total assets at the end of February totaled \$544,189.34 compared to \$544,544.84 this time last year.
- ❖ Old Business:
 - a. Landscaping: David Spare will start the irrigation system installation after Easter. Leon mentioned a landscape artist from Pratt will be willing to donate her efforts for a landscaping plan. David has worked with her before and highly recommends her. It was agreed to ask her for a very simple layout that would require minimum maintenance.
 - b. Fr. Warren brought the group up to date on the condition of the reverse osmosis system in the rectory. Fr. Indicated this was not top priority at this time as the unit is currently not leaking.
- ❖ New Business:
 - a. The accumulated snow on the school roof has resulted in leakage and water in the basement classroom. Also water leaked in the pantry area of the school kitchen. Lamunyon Cleaning & Restoration was contacted to dry out and clean the carpet in the classroom and a bid was received to repair the leakage spots on the school roof. The bid was accepted. The group discussed options regarding the school roof and will continue to look into this matter.
