FINANCE/PROPERTY COUNCIL

- ❖ Met January 17th
- ❖ Members present: Bob Haymaker, G.L. VonFeldt, Dennis Wilson, Sharon Larsen, Carol Jacob, Leon Sanders, Jim Damm, Don Jensen, Fr. Warren & Pam Huffles. Guest: Tom Giessel.
- ❖ Minutes of the December 20th meeting were approved as corrected.
- ❖ The group reviewed the financial reports for December 2011 reflecting \$23,672.20 in income and \$26,487.72 in expenses for a net deficiency of \$2,815.52. Our YTD income is \$31,008 less than last year's while expenses are about \$12,013 more leaving our cash flow \$43,021 behind this time last year. The balance sheet reflects total assets of \$540,073 as of Dec. 21, 2011 compared to \$499,682 at the end of 2010.
- ❖ Old Business: Tom Giessel updated the group on the centennial book and suggested a budget be drawn up to include all centennial expenses. Plans are to take advance orders for the centennial books to better estimate on the number to be printed. It was approved to purchase 500 bookmarks with website and email information along with a centennial prayer.
- ❖ New Business: Fr. Warren presented a request from the Pastoral Council to proceed with an entertainment event during our centennial year. Nuns4Fun have been contacted for a May 5th program to be held at the Larned Community Center. Tickets will be sold. It was approved to allow Pastoral Council to proceed with their plans.
- ❖ Tom Giessel is trying to schedule a Mass to be held at Fort Larned since our parish history is tied to the history of the fort. Date and building location are yet to be decided.
- ❖ Next meeting: February 21, 2012 @ 12:00 Noon.

- ❖ The meeting opened with prayer led by Fr. Warren.
- ❖ The December 15th minutes were approved with a minor date change.
- ❖ Scheduled the calling list for altar servers.
- ❖ Centennial Update: The Centennial book is progressing well. Family histories need to be submitted by February 29th. We are currently looking for pictures (First Communion, Confirmation, and Graduation) from the parish prior to 1950. Tom Giessel is working on plans to have a Mass at Fort Larned on a Saturday evening TBD.

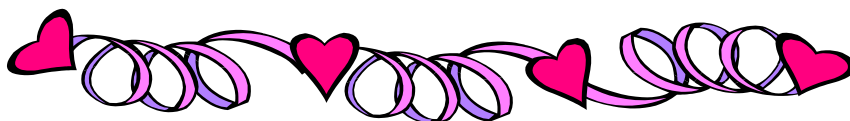
It seems that every PSR class is keeping busy. Our catechists are doing a wonderful job! I am so thankful for all of them!

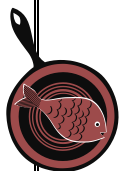
