About

Liturgy



Another word for the Mass is "liturgy", which comes from a Greek word meaning a "public work" or a "service in the name of/on behalf of the people." It is our participation in the work of God, which is for our redemption. It is our service of God and neighbor.

Liturgy typically refers to ritual public worship, and is how people have worshipped God for thousands of years. The ancient Jews were a ritualistic, liturgical people, and as Jesus, the apostles, and almost all the earliest Christians were Jews, it should not be a surprise that the Christian faith instituted worship in this manner. When we participate in the Mass, we join with millions of Christians in their worship of God over the past 2000 years.

The Catechism of the Catholic Church describes the liturgy as an action of Christ's Church. The liturgy is a visible sign of the communion in Christ between God and men. It is our encounter with the Living God. The Mass is divided into two major parts. The first is the Liturgy of the Word, which includes the readings at Mass and the homily. The second part is the Liturgy of the Eucharist, in which Jesus is made present in the form of bread and wine, and we are able to receive Christ inside ourselves.

The first Mass was, of course, instituted by Christ at the Last Supper, which was a Jewish Passover meal. The Passover meal was a ritualistic event, and at every Mass, we make present the events of the Last supper with Jesus instituting the Eucharist for each of us. In the Mass, we are surrounded by the saints and angels as we participate in the heavenly liturgy.

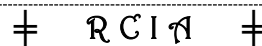

FINANCE/PROPERTY COMMISSION

- ❖ Met July 16th
- ❖ Members present: Bob Haymaker, G.L. VonFeldt, Dennis Wilson, Don Jensen, Jim Damm, Carol Jacob, Sharon Larsen, Fr. Warren. Unable to attend: Leon Sanders & Pam Hutfles.
- ❖ Minutes of the June 18, 2013 meeting were approved as corrected.
- ❖ The group reviewed the financial reports for June reflecting \$18,579.08 in income and \$20,735.83 in expenses for a net income of negative \$2,156.75 for the month. Our net loss for the fiscal year ending June 30 was \$23,672.74. Total assets at the end of June were \$529,119.33 compared to \$553,510.89 this time last year. There was farm income from wheat deposited in July in the amount of \$11,086.47. The contract will be submitted in August to USD #495 Tri-County for the upcoming school year.
- ❖ Old Business:
 - a. Fr. Warren has not heard from Barb Harris @ Pratt regarding landscaping suggestions. The plugged Bermuda grass is doing well.
 - b. The renovation of the restrooms to make them handicap accessible is going to cost about double what we understood the estimate to be. The project is on hold until we get a firm estimate.
 - c. Don reported that the installation of a switch may be sufficient at this time to make the heating system operable in the school building.
 - d. The Pastoral Council meets July 18th and will make a decision on the black triangle behind the crucifix.
 - e. The group discussed comments received concerning the future of the school building. Comments and/or questions are encouraged from all parishioners.

 - a. The group reviewed the annual Parish Internal Controls Questionnaire with no changes from last year and signed it as well as the Parish Fiscal Year-End Report. Both documents will be forwarded to the Diocesan office.

- ❖ The meeting opened with prayer.
- ❖ The minutes of the June 20, 2013 were approved.
- ❖ Scheduled the calling list for servers.
- ❖ Old Business:
 - a. Reviewed the Bylaws. Changes and edits were made to Article VIII: Parish Organizations Section 1 changes included the name committees being changed to commissions since those parish organizations are not time limited. Mary will email to the Council all changes for one final look. Bylaws will then be approved officially at the September 19th meeting. Copies of the updated Bylaws will then be emailed to the chair people of each commission.
 - b. Based on comments and feedback regarding the triangle behind the crucifix, it was determined that the triangle will be removed and the crucifix placed on the stone background. It is anticipated that minor discoloration of the stone will appear, as well as holes in the stone blocks that will be repaired. Fr. Warren will submit a request for change to the Bishop. If permission is obtained then removal of the triangle will move forward. Matt will talk to a masonry professional about repairing the holes.
