- ❖ The meeting opened with prayer.
- ❖ The February 16th minutes were approved.
- ❖ Barbara Hammond discussed plans for advertising the "Bible Bingo" event scheduled for May 5. Tickets were distributed to Pastoral Council members to begin selling. A drawing will be held for door prizes at the event.
- ❖ The Centennial events were discussed. Two hundred and forty-seven histories were received for the Centennial Book.
- ❖ A Mass will be held at Fort Larned on June 2 as an initial Centennial event leading up to the actual celebration in October.
- ❖ The upcoming Parish elections were discussed and Nicki Roof will chair the nominating committee.

FINANCE/PROPERTY COUNCIL

- ❖ Met March 20th
- ❖ Members present: Bob Haymaker, Dennis Wilson, Sharon Larsen, Carol Jacob, Jim Damm, Don Jensen, Leon Sanders, Fr. Warren & Pam Hutfles. Unable to attend: G.L. VonFeldt.
- ❖ Minutes of the February 28, 2012 meeting were approved.
- ❖ The group reviewed the financial reports for February reflecting \$24,606.72 in income and \$19,531.37 in expenses for a net income of \$5,075.35. Our YTD income is \$37,538 less than last year's while expenses are about \$17,900 more leaving our cash flow \$55,438 behind this time last year. The balance sheet reflects total assets of \$544,544.84 as of February 29, 2012 compared to \$516,234.51 at the end of February 2011.
- ❖ Old Business:
 - A. The Mass at Fort Larned in conjunction with our 100th anniversary has been scheduled for June 2 @ 5:30 PM.
 - B. Computers for the office have not been purchased yet. A representative from OPI is scheduled to meet with Fr. Warren, Pam and Brenda on March 21st.
 - C. Don reported that he and G.L. had visited with Jon Flint and Margo Buscher concerning the renewal of the Tri-County lease of the school. After visiting with other counties involved they agreed to increase the rent to \$750/mo effective with the new school year. Payment splits for the utilities and other expenses will remain unchanged. The contract will be negotiated annually.
- ❖ New Business:
 - A. Don mentioned there has been water in the men's restroom of church. He will check the drainage in the area.
 - B. It was recommended that John Hutfles be consulted about landscaping between the school and rectory where the trees were removed. A suggestion was made to install an irrigation system. No decision was made at this time.
