- ❖ Met July 19th

- ❖ Minutes of the June, 2016 meeting were approved as presented.
- ❖ The group reviewed the financial report for June reflecting \$30,690.52 in income and \$24,842.80 in expenses for a net income of \$5,847.72. The balance sheet showed assets of \$442,218.01 compared to \$977,188.35 at the end of June 2015.
- ❖ Jim Haynes with Haynes Electric reviewed the plans for church lighting from PKMR. Jim is looking for alternative vendors to cut costs. Jim will also break the plan into sections so we can implement the plan in stages.
- ❖ We are still waiting on a proposal to network the internet from three buildings to one building.
- ❖ Following discussion it was moved and passed to hire Jerry Ford from Macksville to strip, wax and polish the terrazzo floor in the church vestibule.
- ❖ The Diocese has requested that we record our real estate and buildings on our financial statement. This will show that they belong to us as the Diocese is currently working on setting up each church as its own entity rather than all churches in the Diocese being under the same corporation. This will provide extra protection to the individual parishes if a parish in the Diocese becomes liable for something. It was moved and passed to record our property on the balance sheet at cost.
