FINANCE/PROPERTY COMMISSION

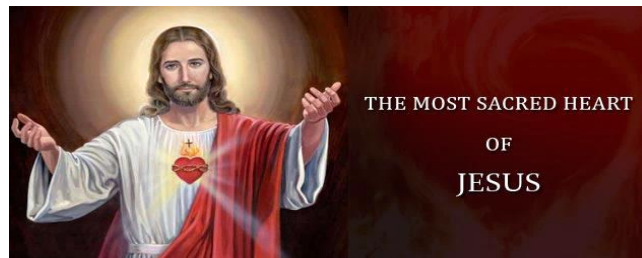
- ❖ Met May 16th
- ❖ Members present: Bob Haymaker, Dennis Wilson, G.L. VonFeldt, Jim Damm, Don Jensen, Kathy Couchman, David Zecha, Leon Sanders, Pam Huffles & Fr. Warren. Unable to attend: Connie Mauney & Jacques Molleker.
- ❖ Minutes of the April meeting were approved.
- ❖ The group reviewed the financial report for April reflecting \$18,649.29 in income and \$22,739.73 in expenses for a deficit of \$4,090.44. The balance sheet showed assets of \$336,016.99.
- ❖ Dennis received a bid for four security cameras. The cost would be \$500 for just the cameras. G.L. moved to have Dennis get a full estimate (all parts and labor for installation) after discussing the wants and needs with Pam and Fr. Warren to determine how many cameras and where they should be placed. A decision will be made once we receive the information.
- ❖ James Grover will allow us to use his lift to repair the beam on the outside of the church for no charge. Jacques is to be in contact with him to set up a time when Jacques can complete the work.
- ❖ A bequest was left to the church by Loraine Hammeke. Per the request of Loraine and her family, it will be used towards the sound system and potentially a piano in the church. McClelland Sound has been contacted and will work with the suggestions of Andrew VonFeldt's sound engineering report.

The devotion to the **Sacred Heart** (also known as the **Most Sacred Heart of Jesus**, *Sacratissimi Cordis Iesu* in Latin) is one of the **most** widely practiced and well-known Roman Catholic devotions, taking **Jesus Christ's** physical **heart** as the representation of His divine love for humanity.

Feast of the Sacred Heart of Jesus

Because our parish bears the name of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, it behooves us to know where this feast originated. Devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus goes back at least to the 11th century, but through the 16th century, it remained a private devotion, often tied to devotion to the Five Wounds of Christ. The Feast of the Sacred Heart is a solemnity in the liturgical calendar of the Roman Catholic Church. It falls 19 days after Pentecost, on a Friday. The earliest possible date is May 29, as in 1818 and 2285. The latest possible date is July 2, as in 1943 and 2038. This year it falls on June 23. The devotion to the Sacred Heart is one of the most widely practiced and well-known Roman Catholic devotions, taking Jesus Christ's physical heart as the representation of his divine love for humanity.

The origin of this devotion is derived from a Roman Catholic nun from France, Saint Margaret Mary Alacoque, who said she learned the devotion from Jesus during a series of apparitions to her between 1673 and 1675, the first on December 27, 1673, and the final one 18 months later, revealing the form of the devotion: reception of Holy Communion on the first Friday of each month, Eucharistic adoration during a "Holy hour" on Thursdays, and the celebration of the Feast.

In the 19th century, at the request of Blessed Mary of the Divine Heart, Pope Leo XIII decreed that the consecration of the entire human race to the Sacred Heart of Jesus should take place on 11 June 1899. In 1856, Pope Pius IX raised the feast as double major. In 1889 it was raised to the double rite of first class. Since 2002, the Solemnity of the Sacred Heart of Jesus is a special Day of Prayer for the Sanctification of Priests. In 2009, the feast marked the beginning of a "Year for Priests". The first Friday of each month is devoted to The Sacred Heart of Jesus.

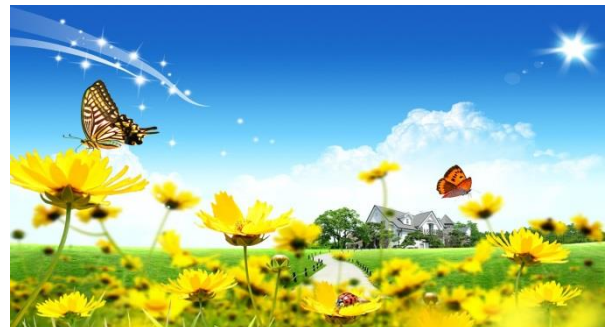

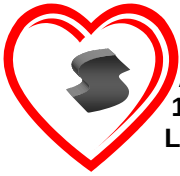
