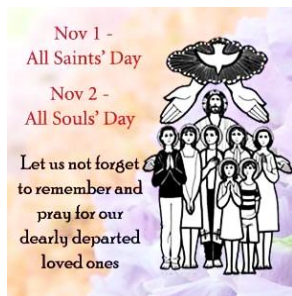

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ALL SAINTS' AND ALL SOULS' DAY



According to the Catechism of the Catholic Church (#957 – 958), since its earliest days the Church has honored with great respect the memory of the dead. Inscriptions on the catacomb walls attest to early Christians praying for the dead, and there is a reference to prayer for the dead in the Old Testament (2 Macc). We believe that

communion with other Christians on earth brings us closer to Christ, and that this is also accomplished by communion with those who have gone before us. This includes those who are in heaven, as well as those who are being purified prior to entry into heaven. The month of November, and specifically the first two days of the month are times to honor those who have gone before us.

November 1st is the Solemnity of All Saints, which is a Holy Day of Obligation. This solemnity is designed to honor all the saints in heaven, both known and unknown. There were many occasions in which a large number of people were martyred at the same time, or within a certain time period, and the names of all of those individuals is not known. They are all considered as saints, however. According to Pope Urban IV, the purpose of this day is to remedy any deficiencies in the faithful's celebration of saints' feasts during the year. There are, of course, many more saints than there are days in the year, and the first mention of a common day to celebrate all the saints is dated to the fourth century. On this date we celebrate eternal happiness in the Kingdom of Heaven.

November 2nd is the Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed, commonly called All Souls Day. From the early days of the Church, the names of departed brethren were recorded. In the sixth century Benedictine monasteries began to commemorate deceased members of their communities around the time of Pentecost (which was called Whitsuntide at the time). Eventually the idea of praying for the deceased spread to other places, and would be held on different days of the year. While the Church prays for the departed throughout the year, All Souls Day is a general, solemn day of commemoration for all the faithful departed, who are in a state of purifications prior to entering into eternal joy in heaven. This place of purification is known as purgatory and requires belief in two realities. The first is that many believers require a period of purifications prior to entering heaven. The second is that prayers and Masses offered by the faithful on earth in some way benefits those who are being purified. It is very common on this date for the faithful to go to cemeteries to pray for their deceased loved ones.

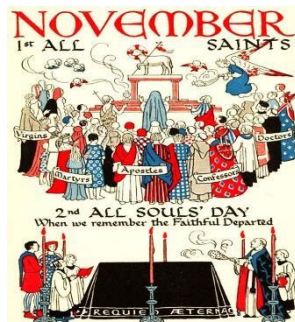


ZAK'S CHEESE
