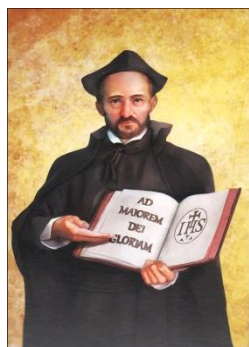

A PRAYER OF ST. IGNATIUS OF LOYOLA AND REDEMPTIVE SUFFERING



I spoke some years ago here at Sacred Heart Parish on the topic of Prayer. My mother figured prominently in this talk as I spoke about her having spent the last years of her life with Pick's Disease, an early age striking version of Alzheimer's. She spent the last nine years of her life living a very important doctrine of our faith, namely Redemptive suffering. Christ redeemed

Mankind by his passion and death, but we are called by our Baptism to be followers of Christ. As members of the Mystical Body of Christ we are commissioned to share in the redemptive action of Jesus Christ.

Until Mom suffered and then died, I never related that suffering is a part of the mystery of love. I had always known that Mom loved me but I had a hard time placing a value on Mom's suffering. It just seemed so unfair. At some time during that trying time, I stumbled across St. Ignatius of Loyola's simple prayer that comes at the end of His writing known as "Spiritual Exercises".

Take, Lord, receive all my liberty, my memory, my intellect and all my will – all that I have and possess. You have given it to me: to you, Lord, I return it! All is yours, dispose of it according to your will. Give me your love and grace, for this is enough for me.

It is difficult, in all honesty, to pray this prayer. I surely don't want to lose my memories of all I hold dear. But yet my mother did this with God's grace. She shared intimately in the redemptive action of Jesus Christ. One of St. Ignatius's spiritual exercises is to contemplate on ways in which you have been loved.

St. Ignatius of Loyola and His Jesuits, The Society of Jesus, devoted themselves to the care of souls, helping people discern God's presence in their lives, in everyday experiences and events. St. Ignatius encourages us to "find God in all things." All who are baptized and are in the state of sanctifying grace make up the Mystical Body of Christ. Will we suffer along with Christ? Will we offer that suffering along with Him to the Father?

St. Ignatius died in 1556, on July 31, his feast day in the Catholic Church.

- ❖ Minutes of the February 18, 2020 meeting were approved as presented.
- ❖ The group reviewed the financial reports for March, April and May 2020. As of the end of May collections are only down \$14,681.54 compared to July of 2018 to May of 2019, which is a little more than one normal weekend. The May balance sheet showed cash of \$448,000.79 compared to \$495,635.35 at the end of May 2019. The credit that we had applied for from the City of Larned (for the Midwest Energy overcharge that was passed on to customers) was applied to our May balance. The credit was \$657.00
- ❖ The bid for repairs to the organ was presented. The bid has been submitted to OCP for a grant. We won't hear if we will be awarded the grant for several months. If was moved that we accept the bid for repair whether we are given the grant or not.

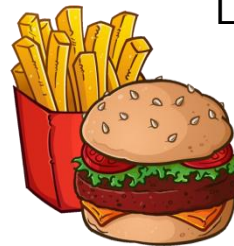
