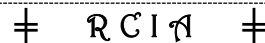

FINANCE/PROPERTY COUNCIL

- ❖ Met July 17th

- ❖ Minutes of the June 19, 2012 meeting were approved.
- ❖ The group reviewed the financial reports for June reflecting \$40,133.94 in income and \$24,247.21 in expenses for a net income of \$15,886.73. Fiscal Year-to-date income was \$24,447.63 compared to \$83,688.33 last year. The balance sheet reflects total assets of \$553,510.89 as of June 29, 2012 compared to \$529,784.68 at the end of June 2011.
- ❖ Old Business:
 - a. Tom Giessel updated the group on the centennial books. After a review of the associated costs it was moved and seconded to increase the price to \$40 from \$30 for books ordered after August 31. Approximately 300 books have been pre-ordered so the group agreed to order a total of 400 books.
 - b. David Spare presented his estimate for sod and a sprinkler system for the church grounds. After discussion it was decided to defer a final commitment until a walk around is completed by the committee and estimates could be submitted for several different scenarios.
 - c. A proposal has not been received from H & B Video for updating the sound system in the choir loft.
- ❖ New Business:
 - a. Charlie Befort shared the latest updates to the Dillons Certificate fund-raising program. Charlie will speak at church regarding these changes.
 - b. The committee reviewed and signed the Internal Controls questionnaire and the annual financial statement.
