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A Walk Through Holy Week



Palm Sunday

PALM SUNDAY Jesus went to Jerusalem and was welcomed by people who were joyfully shouting "Hosanna" and waving palm branches. Palm Sunday marks the beginning of Holy Week and ends with Christ's passion, death, and resurrection. **Bible verses:** The Passion of the Lord is read from the gospel according to Mark 14:1-15:47. Jesus accomplished His mission on earth, and each of us are called to accomplish OUR mission here on earth, as well, by following in His footsteps.



HOLY THURSDAY Jesus instituted the Sacrament of the Holy Eucharist at the celebration of The Last Supper with His 12 apostles.

Bible verses: A reading from the first Letter of Saint Paul to the Corinthians

Brothers and sisters: I received from the Lord what I also handed on to you, that the Lord Jesus, on the night he was handed over, took bread, and, after he had given thanks, broke it and said, "This is my body that is for you. Do this in remembrance of me." In the same way also the cup, after supper, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in my blood. Do this, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of me." For as often as you eat this bread and drink the cup, you proclaim the death of the Lord until he comes.

1 Corinthians 11:23-26

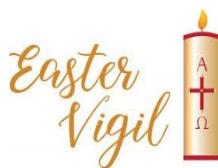
At every Mass, the priest repeats the words of Jesus during the consecration, in remembrance of Him. Then during Holy Communion, we reverently receive Christ's TRUE body and precious blood. On Holy Thursday, Jesus also showed His apostles the importance of serving others by washing their feet, and then He told them to serve others. Thus, we are also called to serve others.



GOOD FRIDAY

GOOD FRIDAY Jesus Christ, who was sinless, suffered and died on the cross for all of our sins, because He loved us!

Bible verses: The Passion of the Lord is read from the gospel according to John 18:1-19:42. Even when Jesus was hanging on the cross and was suffering and dying, He led by example. Jesus showed mercy and forgave people. Jesus wants us to follow Him in our daily lives and forgive people, too. Before He died, Jesus gave His mother, Mary, to John and all of us. Blessed Virgin Mary, pray for us sinners, now and at the hour of OUR death. Amen.



HOLY SATURDAY Jesus passed over from death into life, dispelling darkness and bringing light to the whole world. At the Easter Vigil, the paschal candle is lit, signifying that Christ is the light of the world.

Bible verses: Several bible passages telling about all the things God did for His people are read from the old and new testaments, beginning with the book of Genesis when God created the heavens and the earth and everything in it. "God created man in His image; in the image of God He created him; male and female He created them." Genesis 1:27. "God looked at everything He had made, and He found it very good." Genesis 1:31. On Holy Saturday, we also renew our baptismal promises and our profession of faith. Jesus *still* dispels darkness and brings forth light to the world today. God gives each of us a free will, so let us pray that for the sake of our eternal souls, we will choose to love and serve God instead of Satan.



EASTER SUNDAY Jesus Christ rose from the dead! Easter is the most important feast day of the liturgical church calendar.

Bible verses: A reading from the holy Gospel according to John

On the first day of the week, Mary of Magdala came to the tomb early in the morning, while it was still dark, and saw the stone removed from the tomb. So she ran and went to Simon Peter and to the other disciple whom Jesus loved, and told them, "They have taken the Lord from the tomb, and we don't know where they put him." So Peter and the other disciple went out and came to the tomb. They both ran, but the other disciple ran faster than Peter and arrived at the tomb first; he bent down and saw the burial cloths there, but did not go in. When Simon Peter arrived after him, he went into the tomb and saw the burial cloths there, and the cloth that had covered his head, not with the burial cloths but rolled up in a separate place. Then the other disciple also went in, the one who had arrived at the tomb first, and he saw and believed. For they did not yet understand the Scripture that he had to rise from the dead. John 20:1-9

Salvation came to ALL people through Christ's passion, death and resurrection. Because of Christ's resurrection, the gates of heaven are open to all of us. Let us live our lives in ways that are holy and pleasing to God so that through His infinite love, mercy, and grace, we may spend eternal life in heaven with our God, praising Him forever with all the angels and saints. Thank you, God, for sending us the great gift of Your son, Jesus Christ.

- ❖ Next meeting: April 20, 2021 @ 12:00 Noon

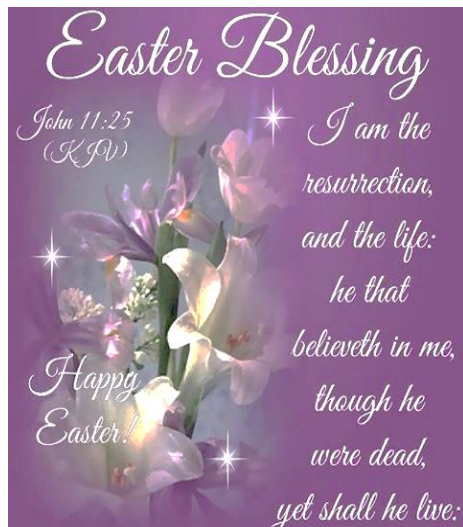
PASTORAL COUNCIL
