Why we will be attending the Midwest Catholic Family Conference and encourage you to do so also!

On August 6 through August 8, 2021 the Midwest Catholic Family Conference will return to Century II in Wichita, KS. Leann and I first attended the Midwest Catholic Family Conference a few years ago. Regis Lopata of our parish encouraged us to attend, and man are we glad we did. First of all, I was concerned that it would just be another Rah Rah event with just a lot of singing and a big screen showing the words like a karaoke machine. My first impression could not have been more wrong. This event is anything but that. The sessions are targeted toward Catholic families, without the Rah Rah. For Leann and I, it has been life altering. Attending this event years ago, has proven to be one of the best decisions we have ever made.

Things that I have learned from attending these conferences include better ways to pray, the importance in praying for the poor souls in purgatory, why Jesus died for us, and a reminder to put my true trust in the Lord.

We have been able to experience several of these events. Last year in 2020, the event did not happen due to Covid concerns. But it is back just in time for 2021. I can't think of something more needed for our Catholic community at this time than this event. I know that personally I am very concerned about our country and the world at large. I believe that an event such as this will help remind all of us of the Catholic faith and to turn to God in time of need.

So what is the "Midwest Catholic Family Conference"? Well, since I am so strongly encouraging you to attend this event, here is what it is all about: Catholic speakers from all over our country are invited to speak on various topics.

The informative talks from these speakers are not glorified sermons, they are spoken from their hearts and are very spiritual and enlightening. The topics are often very timely and hit right at home. On both Saturday and Sunday there is Mass for all attendees. For me watching how they handle the distribution of "Holy Communion" to all attendees (usually around 2500 to 3000) is very impressive. I think what I love the most is watching how many young families attend the conference with all of their small children.

In addition to the speakers, there are various Catholic vendors in attendance displaying many of their Catholic products. I have personally purchased many of their books and pamphlets, and always enjoy visiting with the various vendors.

Speakers from past conferences that really made an impression on me:

Fr. Donald Calloway, author of the book "No Turning Back". His book details his struggle to overcome drug addictions and criminal activities while on his way to a true Catholic conversion to becoming a priest. When he was here back in 2019, he gave the homily at Sunday Mass.

Dr. Scott Hahn, author of "Rome Sweet Rome"

Steven Ray, world traveler, known for his travels to the "Holy Land"

Dr. Ray Guarendi: spoke on raising a Catholic family (very humorous)

Tim Staples, an expert on the Virgin Mary

Jesse Romero, former LA county police officer, author of the book "Lord, Prepare My Hands for Battle"

Terry Beatley, author of "What if We've Been Wrong?", a book about the evils of abortion.

Fr. Michael E. Gaitley, author of "33 Days to Morning Glory". His talk on the 33 Days of Morning Glory was the first one that we had heard at this conference years ago. He currently has a program on "Formed" entitled "Divine Mercy". The first time I heard him talk, I was sold on his idea of 33 Days to Morning Glory. That same weekend we received a special treat from him as he did the homily at the Saturday Mass. Fr. Gaitley is featured in the current "Formed" program that is being offered to our parish every other Sunday morning at 9:00 AM in the Sacred Heart Parish Center and is sponsored and presented by the Sacred Heart Parish Adult Formation Religious Team, of which I am proud to be a member. Programs currently available through the Sacred Heart Religious Team can be viewed on the Catholic website "formed.org". These programs are free for viewing for members of Sacred Heart of Jesus Parish, Larned, KS. Some of the recent programs include "The Search" "Formed Daily" and "Divine Mercy". I personally was first made aware of the programs offered on "formed.org" when I was visited by a Hutchinson, KS priest while I was a patient in the Hutchinson Hospital 4 years ago. Check out "formed.org"!

I mention some of the previous speakers to give you an idea as to the quality of the speakers. Believe me they are top notch!

So far here is the list of speakers lined up for 2021:

Rev. Dennis McManus: Teacher at Georgetown University since 1997. We heard him speak back in 2019 about his experience as an exorcist. Very eye opening.

Dr. Edward Sri: We have seen him in various programs on "Formed". Wonderful speaker!

Terry Barber: Founder of Saint Joseph Communications. We heard him speak a few years ago about how to spread the faith. This guy is full of energy for the Lord!

Rev. John Lanzrath, pastor of St. John the Evangelist Parish, El Dorado, KS. I don't recall having heard Rev. John speak before, but I have seen him in programs put on by Kapaun's Men and I am confident in his message.

Every speaker delivers a meaningful message. As I have said in the past, my main aim in life is to reach Heaven after I die. I really feel that this conference is a very useful tool that will help us realize what awaits us after death. This conference is available to all faiths.

Registration can be done through their website: <https://catholicfamilyconference.org>. There is a fee for attendance, and there is an option to purchase meal tickets for both Saturday and Sunday. Leann and I will spend both Friday and Saturday in motels in Wichita, because the programs often start at 8:00 AM both days. On Friday we pick up our packet and itinerary and review the list of speakers, and visit Catholic vendors. I personally invite you to attend this extraordinary event. I guarantee you won't be disappointed!
