- ❖ Minutes of the August 17, 2021 meeting were approved.
- ❖ The group reviewed the financial reports for August 2021 which showed income of \$48,443.08 and expenses of \$24,613.40. The August, 2021 balance sheet showed cash of \$477,394.88 compared to \$457,286.83 at the end of August 2020.
- ❖ Jim Mitchell shared that the Parish Center sound system speakers are not working. Jim called McClelland Sound and they feel that the DDS (digital sound system) box is not working. McClelland is currently trying to locate the part for us.
- ❖ Pam shared that she contacted Dan Stremel from Dodge City Diocese regarding the Trane refund. Dan in turn emailed Tim Stalsberg, Trane Collection Analyst requesting a refund by 9-29-2021.

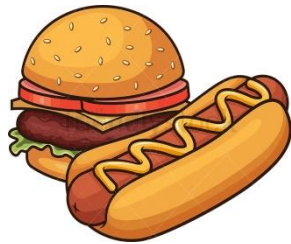
