**Centennial Celebration
of Sacred Heart Parish**



What and Why should Sacred Heart Parish be celebrating on October 28th? A celebration is a time to give thanks to God and to the many dedicated parishioners for the many blessings of the past one hundred years. Pioneer priests as far back as the 16th century began planting the seeds of the Catholic faith in Pawnee County. Native Indians, soldiers, and railroad workers nurtured the seeds which finally evolved into the one Catholic parish in Pawnee County.

A red brick building called Sacred Heart Church became a reality in 1912. As the parish grew, a school was added in 1936. Eventually there was a need for a larger worship space. Through the industrious work of dedicated Catholics, the present church building was completed in 1960.

Today one hundred years later, Sacred Heart Parish in Larned sings its songs of gratitude to our gracious God and to all former and present parishioners who call Sacred Heart their home parish. There is a call for rejoicing and festivities to mark one hundred years of religious worship and liberty in Pawnee County.

SACRED HEART PARISH will be hosting the Larned Chamber of Commerce Coffee Hour on Thursday, October 25th in Celebration of our Centennial. The event will be at the **Jordaan Memorial Library, 502 Broadway St.**, beginning at 9:30 am. We will be presenting Centennial books to the Library, Santa Fe Trail Center and Fort Larned National Historic Site. All parishioners are invited to attend.
