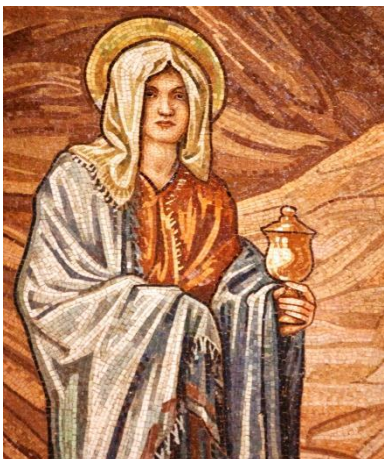

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## St. Mary Magdalene



Some of you may recall the article in the January issue of the Sacred Heart Beat. It described the conversion of Saint Paul on the road to Damascus. Paul went from being a persecutor of Christians to God's messenger of the good news to many. This illustrates for us God's endless love and mercy for us. Need another example?

St. Mary Magdalene is one of the greatest saints of the Bible and a legendary example of God's mercy and grace. The precise dates of her birth and death are unknown, but we do know she was present with Christ during his public ministry, death and resurrection. She is mentioned at least a dozen times in the Gospels.

Mary Magdalene has long been regarded as a prostitute or sexually immoral in western Christianity, but this is not supported in the scriptures. It is believed she was a Jewish woman who lived among Gentiles, living as they did.

The Gospels agree that Mary was originally a great sinner. Jesus cast seven demons out of her when he met her. After this, she told several women she associated with and these women also became followers.

There is also debate over if Mary Magdalene is the same unnamed woman, a sinner, who weeps and washes Jesus' feet with her hair in the Gospel of John. Scholars are skeptical this is the same person.

Despite the scholarly dispute over her background, what she did in her subsequent life, after meeting Jesus, is much more significant. She was certainly a sinner whom Jesus

saved, giving us an example of how no person is beyond the saving grace of God.

These two Saints and their life stories provide great comfort to me. It clearly shows God's love for all. We need only to accept it and enter into a loving relationship with him.

Her Feast Day is 22 July. She is the patron of contemplative life, converts, glove makers, hairdressers, penitent sinners, people ridiculed for their piety, perfumeries, pharmacists, sexual temptation, tanners, and women.

**VALUE THEM BOTH**

In 2019, the Kansas Supreme Court issued a ruling that "discovered" a right to an abortion in the 1859 Kansas Constitution. This decision puts at risk all existing pro-life laws that protect women and their unborn children from the abortion industry. In January 2021, the Kansas Legislature stood up to the abortion industry to support women and babies. They voted to put the Value Them Both amendment on the ballot the next year. Now, Kansans will get the final say with a vote on the amendment in August of 2022. Value Them Both will allow Kansans to, once again, regulate the abortion industry. Vote YES on August 2<sup>nd</sup>!
